The Centenary of the departure from Queensland on 24th September 1914 of Australian Army Nursing Service sisters, bound for World War One

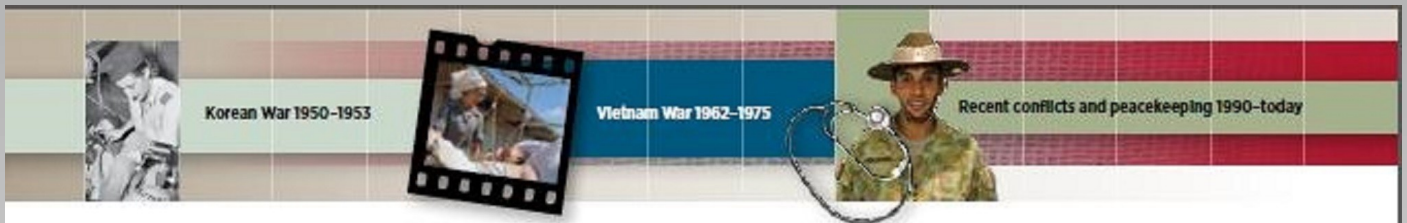
WHERE: War Nurses Memorial Park, cnr Bourbong & Takalvan Streets, Bundaberg
