Privileges of membership

Associate members may attend general meetings however they have no voting rights and may only speak on invitation of the Chair.

Status of membership

Associate members are to renew their membership in January of each year by payment of the approved subscription to the association treasurer. Payment methods are outlined in the association newsletter which associate members will receive electronically
