- Please also advise if your Association will be bringing your banner to Bundaberg.

Please enter all required information on the booking form.

- It is important for us to know who the couples in your group are so that they are not split when we allocate tables. Bundaberg's tradition is to have a mix of visitors and Bundaberg members at each table to promote camaraderie. We aim to have a minimum of two individuals or two couples of any one group on each table. The column at the left headed '{' can be used to bracket couples. Should there be 3 who want to sit together let us know using this method.
- All former or current servicewomen and servicemen wishing to have the free digital portrait taken at the luncheon should indicate same with a tick in the right hand column.
- Special diets – must be noted. Persons with diabetes can have varying needs – if your tolerance is likely to differ to the normal requirement, please advise in advance.
- Some information provided will be included on our attendance sheets and then each person will be invited to autograph the sheet which will become part of our history.

LUNCHEON: Where feasible, you are encouraged to share a cab with friends staying in your motel area.

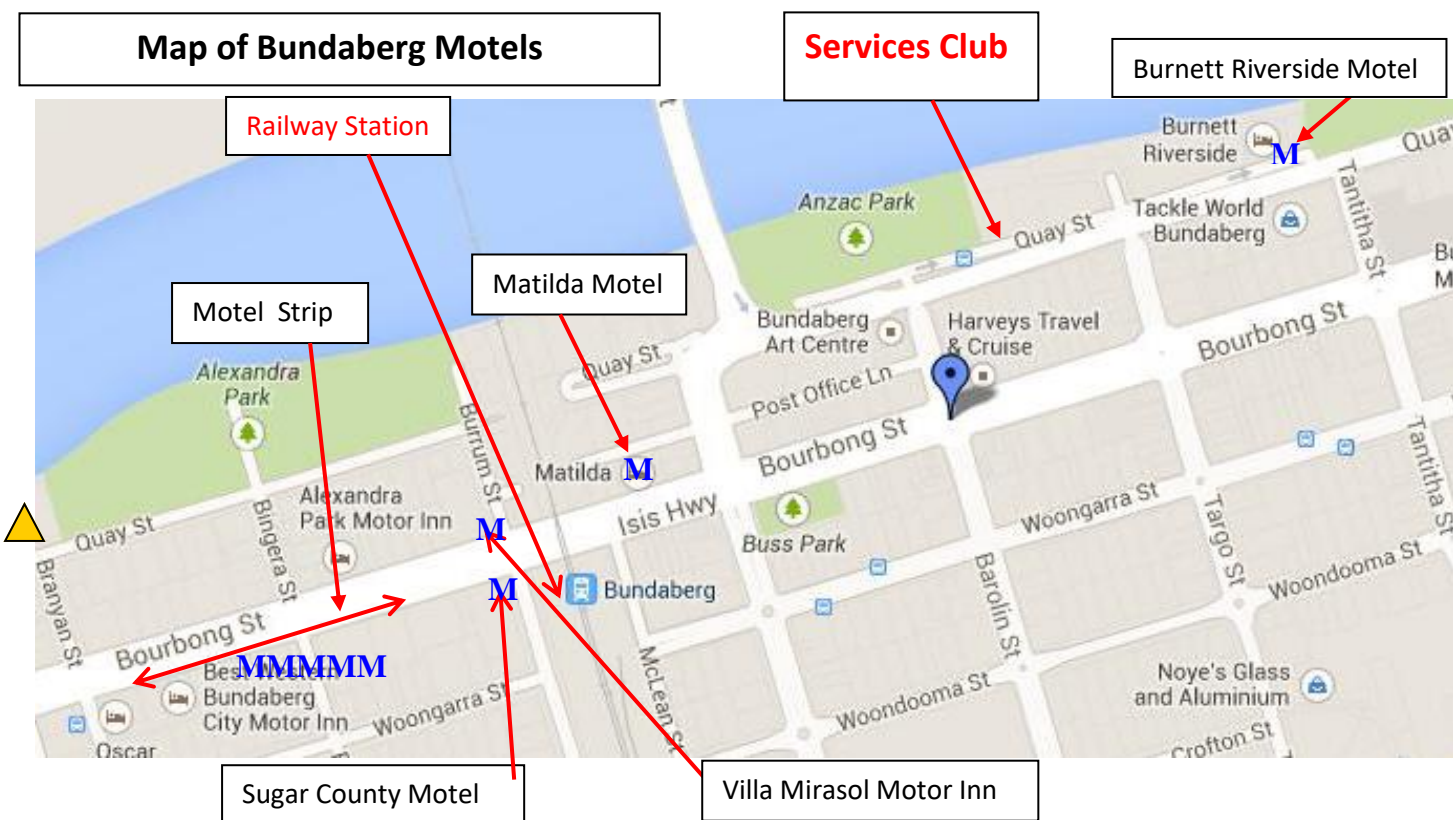
